Living with substance use disorder can be a lonely, unforgiving situation, leaving women at their most vulnerable. Dove House is where women come to reclaim and rebuild their lives. The Doves are able to stay for up to two years, and during that time they do the hard, life-changing work of learning to love themselves, trust themselves, and believe in who they are. When they leave, they don't just leave sober. They leave stronger, whole, and ready to function confidently in the world without drugs and alcohol.

Resilience looks different for every woman, but courage is a part of every recovery journey at Dove House. Each of our Doves bravely faces the traumas that brought them to substance use. At each step, our staff walks alongside them with encouragement, compassion, and accountability.

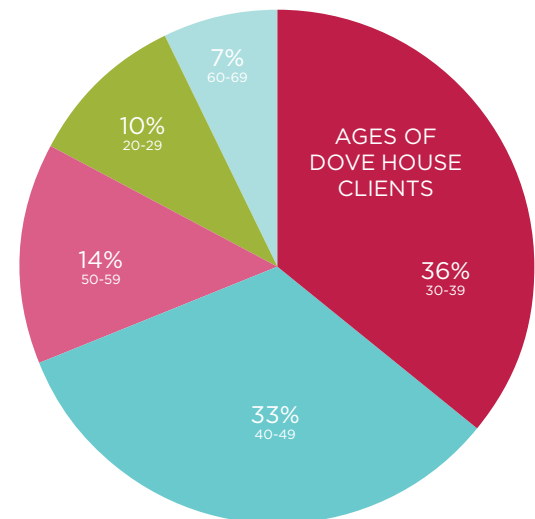
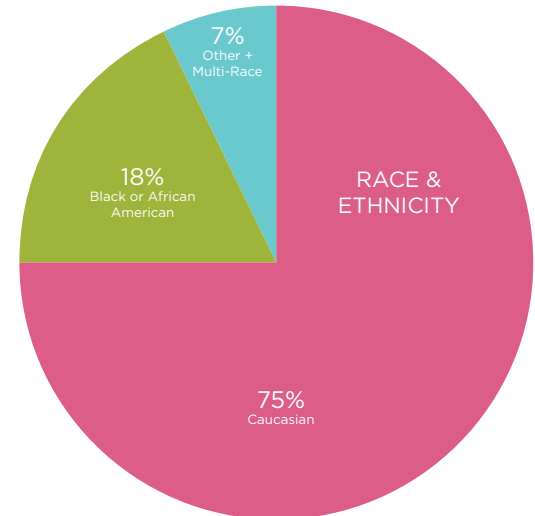

## BUILDING STRONG FUTURES

As a result of their disease, the women we serve have missed out on pivotal moments of their lives -building a career, raising children, having relationships with their family and friends.

### DOVE HOUSE HELPS WOMEN ENVISION A BRIGHTER FUTURE.

Substance use disorder rewires how a person thinks, feels, and responds. But during their time at Dove House, sober and surrounded by safety, structure, and support, the brain begins to heal. The catalyst of that healing is our holistic approach, which includes trauma-informed therapy, peer recovery coaching, and a community of women supporting one another in recovery. Community partners bring critical life skills to enhance independence and life outside the walls of Dove House. Classes like financial literacy, healthy relationships, parenting classes, and arts programming add critical elements to the success of our Doves.

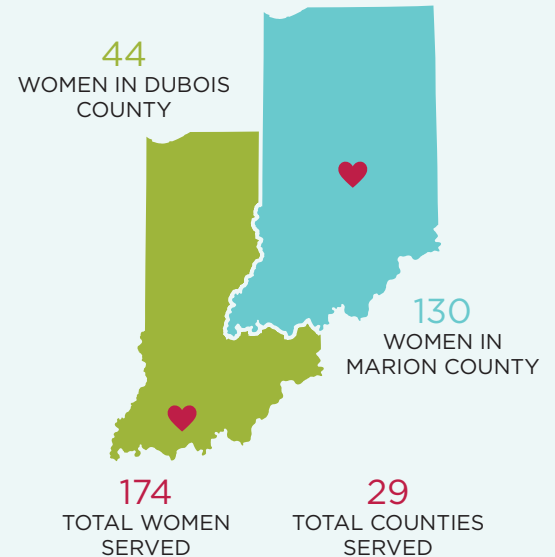
